The annual meeting of the Sunset Beach Sanitary District Board of Equalization was held at the Sunset Beach Woman's Club, on Thursday, July 10th, 2019, at 7:00 p.m.

President Hoad called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

## PRESENTATION OF 2019-20 PRELIMINARY ASSESSMENT ROLL

Assessor Willdan Financial Services representative, Tony Thrasher, presented the Sunset Beach Sanitary District Fiscal Year 2019-20 Preliminary Assessment Roll to the Board of Directors for their review, discussion and possible approval.

<u>BOARD HEARING OF PUBLIC INPUT AND PROTESTS:</u> No public input or protests were presented.

<u>REVIEW AND DISCUSSION:</u> Assessor Thrasher summarized the assessment totals and the public notification process that took place. It was confirmed that the "total commercial sewer units" amount was a preliminary figure that was expected to change after all water consumption records had been obtained from the applicable cities.

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-07-01 TO ACCEPT ASSESSMENT ROLL: Director Regnier moved to adopt Resolution No. 2019-07-01 to examine, rectify, equalize, and approve the 2019-20 Assessment Roll as presented, with any minor adjustments deemed necessary after final calculations have been made, as noted above, and the 2019-20 Secured Roll from the County of Orange was received. Secretary Woods seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

The Clerk agreed to separately invoice the city sewage fees to the City of Huntington Beach for a total amount of \$8,000 (\$200 x 8 x 5).
